Increased manufacturing capacity with £330k investment in machine tools

With an increasing order book for hydraulic components and test equipment, Webtec took a decision in July to invest in two new machine tools to help increase production capacity. Both were delivered in late October and have been carefully selected to expand on Webtec's existing investment in flexible manufacturing.

The new Finnish manufactured Fastems is a 12-Station "Flexible Pallet Container" that connects to an existing twin-pallet Matsuura milling centre. Features include:



- Scheduling and ordering of pallets to auto-load the Matsuura
- Maximum number of pallets increased from 2 to 12
- More dedicated fixtures giving much reduced set-up times
- Increased un-manned production
- 24hr running times possible

The Matsuura milling centre has been simultaneously upgraded with more tools and improved swarf handling.

The new Japanese manufactured Nakamura-Tome WT150 twin spindle, twin turret, turning centre is similar to two existing lathes that Webtec owns and that have proven to be excellent investments. Features include:



- Capability of machining highly intricate turned parts
- Increased one-hit machining capacity
- Shorter cycle times
- Components machined complete with only washing required
- Auto bar feed
- Builds on existing investment in Nakamura lathes
